JOB TITLE: Nuclear Medicine Technologist

REPORTS TO: Director - Non-Invasive Imaging

JOB CLASSIFICATION: Non-Exempt

GENERAL DUTIES: Performs nuclear medicine cardiac procedures

TYPICAL PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Requires full range of body motion including handling and lifting patients, manual and finger dexterity, and eye-hand coordination. Requires standing and walking for extensive periods of time. Occasionally lifts and carries items weighing up to 50 pounds. Requires corrected vision and hearing to normal range. Involves working under stressful conditions and occasional irregular hours. Involves minimal exposure to communicable diseases and bodily fluids and occasional exposure to patients injected with radioactive pharmaceuticals. Exposure to radioactive materials is expected.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES: Critical features of this job are described under the headings below. They may be subject to change at any time due to reasonable accommodation or other reasons. Management may add or reassign additional duties and responsibilities to this position as needed.

1. Start I.V.'s and inject radiopharmaceuticals.
2. Perform cardiac imaging and analysis.
3. Perform quality control on cameras and hot lab instruments.
4. Radiation safety procedures and record keeping.
5. Archive scan data.
6. Assist cardiologist and nurse in emergency situations.

MENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Skill in intravenous puncture skills.
- Knowledge of cardiac scanning principles and SPECT imaging.
- Understanding of radiation protection and A.L.A.R.A. principles.
- Ability to critique image quality and troubleshoot technical issues.
- Skill in attention to detail and accuracy.
- Ability to communicate clearly with co-workers and patients.
- Ability to behave in a manner that exemplifies respect for others and the spirit of teamwork.
- Ability to use methods of protection from chemical, radiation, and bio-hazardous materials.

EDUCATION: Graduate of an accredited nuclear medicine training program.

EXPERIENCE: Experience with cardiac imaging and I.V. puncture skills required.
